In 2021, unrestricted revenue (defined as non-grant related revenue) decreased by **1.7%**, down from \$710,225 in 2020. And expenses grew by **16.4%**. Lower revenue & higher costs are due to expanding inflation amid a global pandemic and an increase in organizational memberships contributing to a decrease in individual membership dollars.

Cash on Hand and Investments

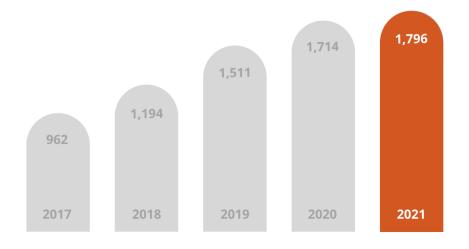
Cash on hand and investments as of December 31, 2021 was \$1,060, 590.74, \$94,920.50 ahead of our projection of \$965,670.24. Cash on hand and investments increased by **18.2%** in 2021, from



Cost of Membership

All expenses not directly associated to conference, technical assistance or the learning management system are considered in support of our main purpose of providing membership benefits, or General & Administrative costs. In 2021, CFHA's General & Administrative costs totaled to be \$401,383, meaning that \$281 was spent on each member during the year. Please note that this amount exceeds the cost of membership.

Individual Members

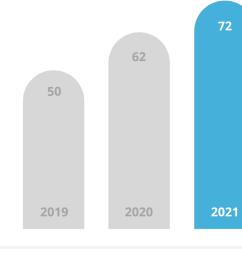
In 2021, CFHA experienced an **4.5 %** increase in individual memberships from 1,714 to 1,796 members.

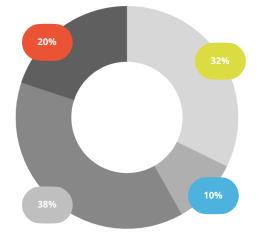
Organizational Memberships
